### **Federal Funding & Criteria**



- 2013 35W Project Plan Update will position Orange Line for federal funding process
- Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century Act (MAP-21)
- Changes to New Starts and Small Starts criteria

"The clustering of development around a transit investment is a key measure of the value of the transit project."

- FTA Capital Investment Grants (New Starts)
  - Major transit capital projects (>\$250M)
  - \$1.87B allocated for FY13
  - Past local projects include
     Central, Hiawatha, Northstar
- Small Starts:
  - Subset of New Starts program
  - \$112.9M allocated for FY13
  - Total capital cost < \$250M</li>
  - Federal share < \$75 million</li>



## **Small Starts Program Criteria**



- Economic Development (planned)
  - Transit-supportive plans and policies
  - Zoning for mixed use, TOD
  - Plans to improve pedestrian facilities
  - Policies to limit parking
  - Policies to maintain and increase affordable housing



## **Small Starts Program Criteria**



- Affordable Housing policies and tools
  - Density bonuses
  - Inclusionary zoning
  - Zoning for housing diversity
  - Affordability covenants
  - Acquisition, rehab, and development funding



## **Small Starts Program Criteria**



- Land Use (existing)
  - Development character
  - Status and stats of projects
  - Pedestrian facilities
  - Parking supply
  - Affordable housing supply
