- In FTA Small Starts Project Development








## **2016 CTIB Grant Project**

Ongoing Project Development activities:


- Project staffing and expenses
- Environmental documentation
- Design/Engineering contracts
- Right-of-way acquisition
  - Following environmental clearance
  - Mitigates project risks prior to FTA rating





## **Orange Line Funding**

- Estimated Capital Cost: \$150M (2017 \$)
- Funds secured 2014-2015: \$31M (20.6%)
- Identification of 10% local shares
- Seeking all non-federal funding commitments mid-2016
- Project estimate will be updated during
   Project Development phase



# **2016 Funding- Uses & Sources**


- \$10.74M CTIB Request for 2016 activities
  - \$1.44M Design/Engineering/PD Other
  - \$9.29M PD ROW Acquisition
- •2016 Grant match funding
  - \$0.8M Met Council- local/federal (5%)
  - \$3.1M Local- counties (17%)
  - \$3.2M State (18%)
  - \$10.7M CTIB (60%)

• \$17.9M Total project activities in 2016




# **2016 Funding- Uses by Category**

- \$2.4M PD- Engineering/Project Activities
  - 60% CTIB
  - 10% State + Council- Local
  - 30% Council- Federal
  - All match sources secured



2016 PD- Engineering

- \$15.49M PD- ROW Purchase Activities
  - 60% CTIB
  - 20% State (5% secured/15% requested)
  - 20% Local (17% secured/3% requested)
- Land acquisition depends on added match

   Project Environmental Work


