




I-35W Corridor


- Most heavily-traveled express bus corridor
 - 14,000 existing bus riders each weekday on 26 routes
 - Several stations already operational
- Who are Orange Line riders?
 - Improve access to 30,000 suburban jobs
 - Better serves all-day, evening, weekend markets
 - Better serves non-downtown trips,
 especially to the 494 corridor





METRO Orange Line

- 17 miles, 11 Stations
- Access, comfort, and technology improvements
- Complements existing express service
- 10-minute service during peak
- 15-minute service midday and night
- Service 20 hours a day, 7 days a week
- Construction starts in 2017
- Open for service in 2019









Improved Fleet with All-Door Boarding









Leveraging Previous Investments


- I-35W & 46th Street Station
- Downtown bus lanes (MARQ2)
- Bus-only shoulders
- MnPASS lanes
- New investments complete BRT vision
 - Lake Street Station
 - Knox Avenue transitway
 - Technology, amenities at existing stations
- Supports redevelopment and reinvestment planned at BRT stations

Lake Street Station

During peak hours, over 100 buses per hour will connect Lake Street to the heart of downtown in 7 minutes

Nov. 2015: Beginning engineering this fall





Project Funding



- Estimated Capital Cost: \$150M (2017 \$)
- Funds secured: \$31M (20.6%)
- State share needed in 2016: \$12.1M



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
